

UBC Okanagan Summer Field Course in Biology

BIOL 371 (3) Flora of British Columbia

July 4 - 14, 2017

Course Description:

Flora of BC, plant identification, and biogeoclimatic zones. Two-week (10-day) course; daily field exercises; equivalent of three lecture hours and three lab hours each day. **Course has a supplemental field trip fee of \$75 in addition to tuition fees.** Students must arrange their own transportation to and from field locations.

Prerequisite: One of BIOL 201, BIOL 203, BIOL 250 and successful completion of 48 academic credits.
