

# UBC Okanagan Summer Field Course in Biology

BIOL 372 (3) Field Ornithology

May 15 – 26, 2017

## Course Description:

Field study of birds. Two-week (10 day) course; daily field exercises (early mornings); equivalent of three lecture hours and three lab hours each day. Offered during spring migration. **Course has a supplemental field trip fee of \$75 in addition to tuition fees.** Students must arrange their own transportation to and from field locations.

*Prerequisites:* One of BIOL 201, BIOL 203, BIOL 204, BIOL 250 and successful completion of 48 academic credits.
